LATN 121 - Elementary Latin (4 credit hours)

Course Description:

Grammar and vocabulary necessary for fundamental reading skills. Assumes prior experience in Latin. Admission only by proficiency examination. Credit may be received for only one of the following: 109/110 or 121.

SAMPLE COURSE OVERVIEW

Latin 121 is designed to offer you structured, sustained practice in reading and analysis of basic Latin, as well as structured analysis of basic elements of the English language. The course will provide classroom instruction, followed by outside assignments designed to solidify concepts learned in class.

ITEMIZED LEARNING OUTCOMES

Upon successful completion of Latin 121 students will be able to:

1. Decipher the elements within Latin sentences in order to understand what is being said;
2. Recite differing forms of words, with the understanding of what each form means;
3. Hear and respond to basic commands and short expressions;
4. Read with understanding out-of-context sentences and short paragraphs written in Latin.
