Tech2Teach Advisement Guide - BA in Elementary Education ONLINE program

Students intending to transfer from a SC Technical College into the online BA in Elementary Education should use this guide. This UofSC Columbia online degree is made available via the UofSC Palmetto College degree completion program. If you intend to transfer to the UofSC Columbia on-campus program, contact the Tech2Teach advisor for the appropriate advisement guide.

Admission Requirements

To be admitted to the UofSC online BA in Elementary Education you must:

- have a collegiate summary GPA of at least 2.5 as calculated by the UofSC Admissions Office.
- have successfully completed a minimum of 30 credit hours from coursework listed below (not all courses listed below need to be met for admission):

Each of the requirements listed below will fulfill a requirement in the BA in Elementary Education; however, it is <u>not</u> recommended that you take all courses listed prior to transferring. Ideally you would transfer to the online UofSC BA in Elementary after completion of 30 - 45 credit hours from courses listed below.

Also, you are <u>not</u> required to take the courses listed below in any particular order. Rather, this is a guide for you and your Technical College advisors to use when making course selection. Courses must be passed with a grade of C or higher in order to be considered for transfer credit.

*Students must meet the UofSC-College of Education Foreign Language requirement to finish the BA in Elementary Education. Students can take the 101 and 102 levels of the same foreign language at the technical college to meet this requirement. One of the two foreign language classes will meet 3 hours of required electives in the BA in Elementary. Students who do not take 6 hours of the same Foreign Language at the technical college will take a placement test upon admission to UofSC and may exempt the Foreign Language requirement.

Timeline

Students completing at least 30 credit hours from above prior to admission would likely finish the online BA in Elementary Education in three years beginning in a fall semester.

Students completing at least 45 hours from the above list (including EDU 201 and EDU 241) could be on track to finish the program in 2.5 years beginning in a spring semester.
